COVID-19 travel restrictions and testing requirements for fully vaccinated travellers

Check before you travel

UK > USA

- Fully vaccinated travellers are allowed to enter the United States of America
- Fully vaccinated travellers are not required to quarantine on arrival in the United States of America
- Travellers must take one of the below tests no more than 1 day before the first scheduled departure time.

Testing types

Antigen Test no more than 1 day before departure

PCR Test no more than 1 day before departure

Rapid PCR Test no more than 1 day before departure

USA > UK

- Fully vaccinated travellers can enter the United Kingdom from the United States of America
- Fully vaccinated travellers do not need to take a PCR or Antigen COVID-19 test to enter the United Kingdom.
- Travellers must book an Arrivals Day 2 PCR COVID-19 test prior to travel to the United Kingdom and take the test on or before day
