COVID-19 travel restrictions and testing requirements for fully vaccinated travellers

Check before you travel

UK > USA

- Fully vaccinated travellers are allowed to enter the United States of America
- Fully vaccinated travellers are not required to quarantine on arrival in the United States of America
- Fully vaccinated travellers must have an original printed or electronic negative COVID-19 test result. Travellers must take one of the below tests no more than 3 days before the first scheduled departure time

Testing types

Antigen Test no more than 3 days before departure

PCR Test no more than 3 days before departure

Rapid PCR Test no more than 3 days before departure

□ Certificate of negative COVID-19 test result

USA > UK

- Fully vaccinated travellers can enter the United Kingdom from the United States of America
- Fully vaccinated travellers do not need to take a COVID-19 test to enter the United Kingdom
- Travellers must book an Arrivals Day 2 COVID-19 Antigen test prior to travel to the United Kingdom

Antigen Test on or before day 2 of arrival
