COVID-19 travel restrictions and testing requirements for fully vaccinated travelers

Check before you travel

USA --> UK

- Fully vaccinated travelers can enter the United Kingdom from the United States of America
- Fully vaccinated travelers do not need to take a COVID-19 test to enter the United Kingdom
- Travelers must book a COVID-19 PCR test prior to travel to the United Kingdom

Testing types

PCR Test on or before day 2 of arrival

Proof of Arrivals Day 2 PCR test

UK --> USA

- Fully vaccinated travelers are allowed to enter the United States of America
- Fully vaccinated travelers are not required to quarantine on arrival in the United States of America
- Fully vaccinated travelers must have an original printed or electronic negative COVID-19 test result. Travelers must take one of the below tests no more than 1 day before the first scheduled departure time

Testing types

Antigen Test no more than 1 day before departure

PCR Test no more than 1 day before departure

Rapid PCR Test no more than 1 day before departure
