



Skift Travel Health Index

August 2023 Highlights

Hong Kong is back in business. Travel performance boomed in August 2023, but talk of full recovery is still premature, as 2019 wasn't a particularly good year with widespread protests impacting travel demand in the country.

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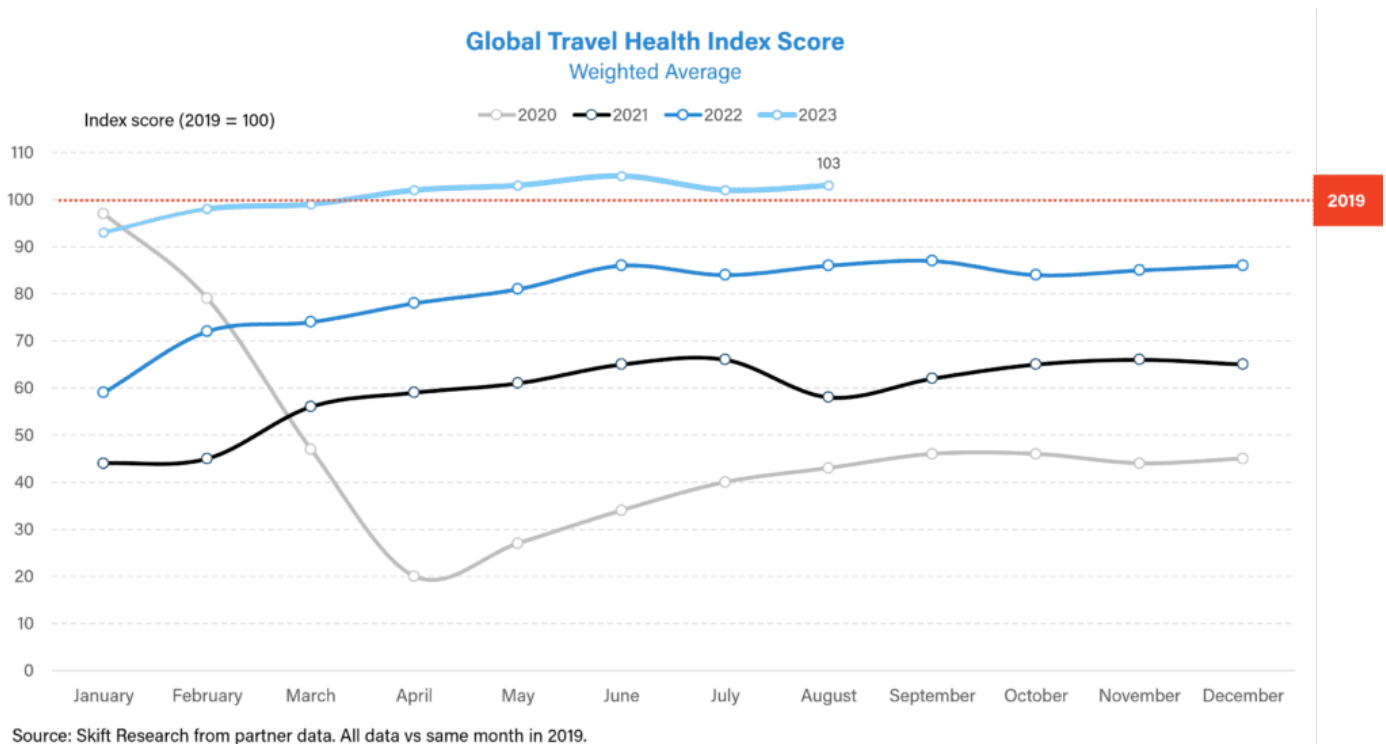
Executive Summary

The Skift Travel Health Index maintained past trends this year, growing by 1 percentage point (pp) over July 2023 to stand at 103 this month.

This month, Hong Kong experienced a significant 23 pp increase, a first since we started tracking global travel recovery. While the country's travel industry is showing considerable improvement, the index in August 2023 is indexed to performance in August 2019. This period in 2019 was a month of softening travel demand in Hong Kong as a result of the protests. Therefore, while there is an uptick in travel performance in the country, it may not necessarily be back to the pre-pandemic average.

Travel Health Shows Positive Gains Over the Past Month

The Skift Travel Health Index gained 1 pp in August 2023 and now stands at 103.



Travel performance in Hong Kong, which had taken a nosedive since the pandemic hit and has struggled to recover ever since witnessed a dramatic uptick in August 2023. For the first time since 2020, Hong Kong has almost made a complete recovery to 2019 levels and stands at 99.7 points.

The travel industry in Hong Kong is undoubtedly on a growth trajectory, but it is vital to note that August 2023's performance is indexed to that of August 2019. This was one of the months when protests and unrest in the country were at their peak. As a result, while tourism is rebounding, it has not entirely recovered to its pre-pandemic average.

Hong Kong's Progress to Travel Recovery

Hong Kong registered more than 4 million tourist arrivals in August, a 13.6% increase over July 2023; however, they still remain below average pre-pandemic levels. Even during the period of unrest in the country in August 2019, the city welcomed 3.6 million visitors. This number, however, was close to 6 million back in August 2018.

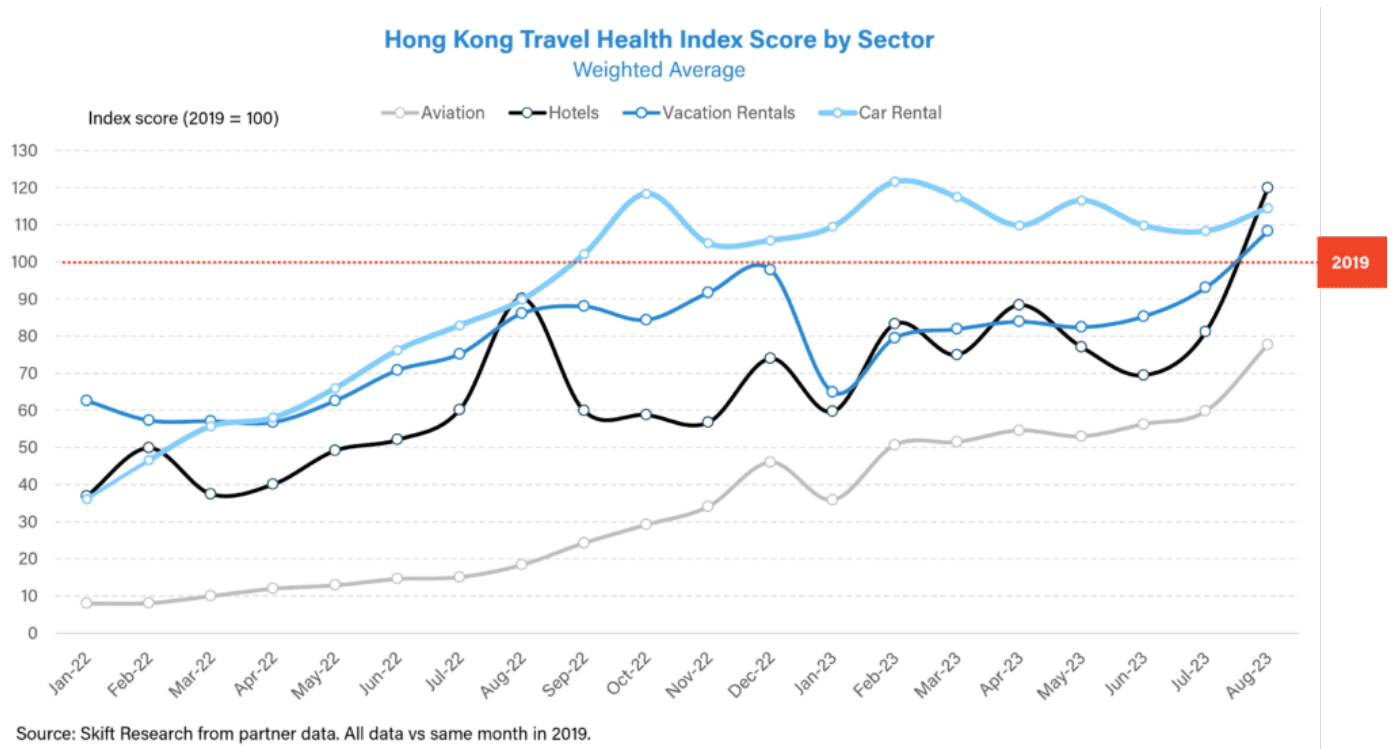
Tourism in the country continues to be largely dependent on travelers from Mainland China. The number of Chinese tourists traveling to Hong Kong has reached 84% of the pre-pandemic average from 2017 to 2019 as of August 2023.

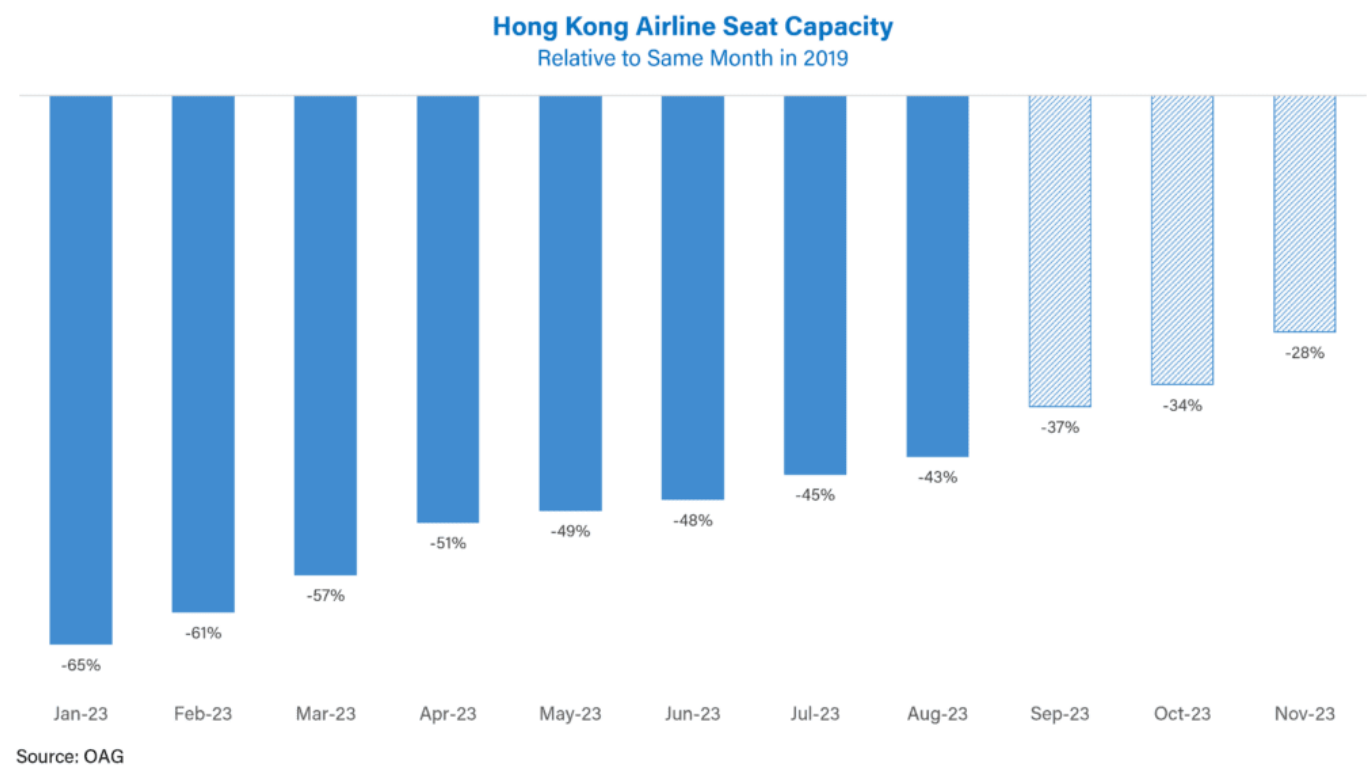

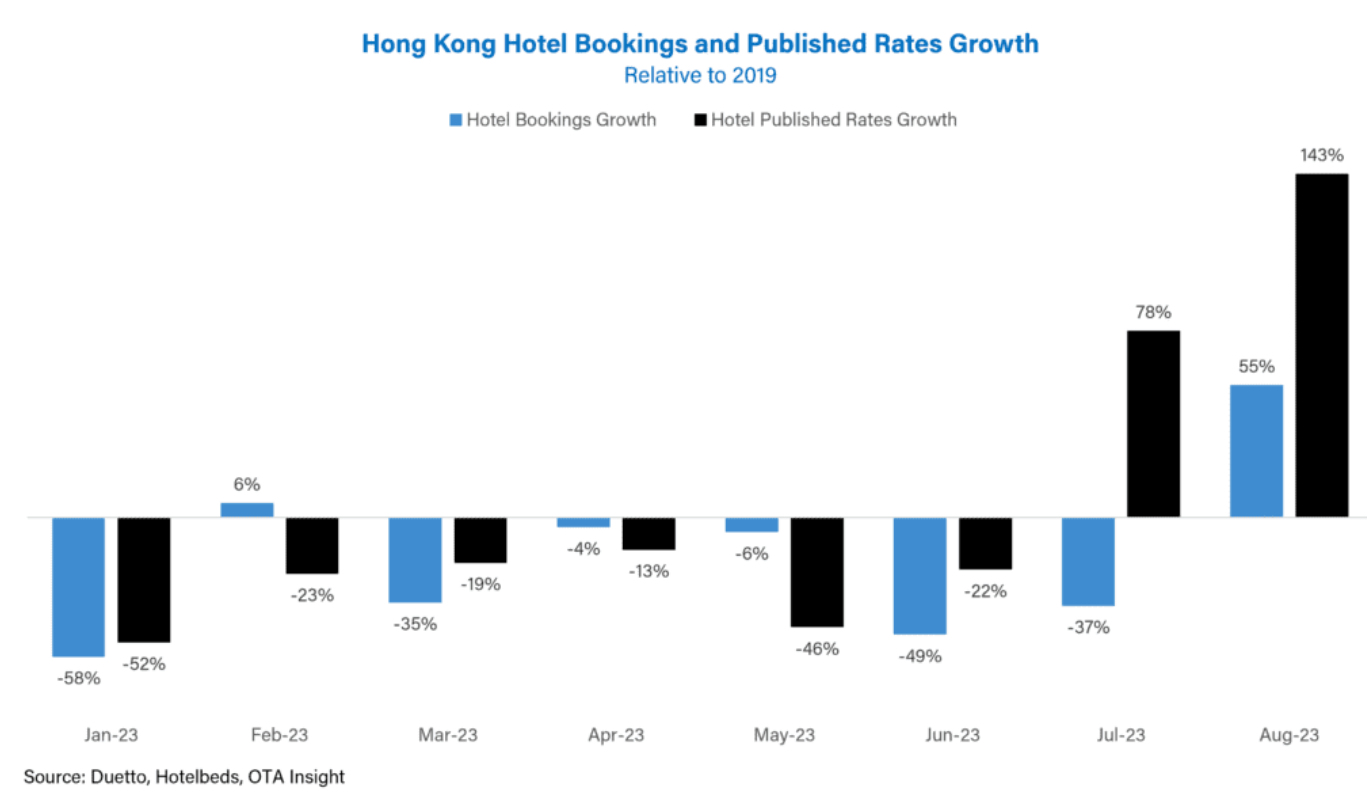
Except for airlines, all sectors in Hong Kong have surpassed 2019 levels of travel performance this month.



The delayed recovery in airline seat capacity has slowed the sector’s revival. In February this year, the country launched the “Hello Hong Kong” campaign, collaborating with local airlines to give away plane tickets to the country, which seems to have accelerated recovery. The gap seems to be shrinking in the coming months, but there are still issues like staffing shortages that have stalled recovery.



Hotel bookings were significantly higher than those in August 2019. Hotel published rates have also increased substantially. Given that hotels struggled with low demand during this period in 2019, these numbers may be the result of under-indexing.



In order to promote tourism in the coming months, the Hong Kong Tourism Board (HKTB) plans to host flagship events such as the Hong Kong Wine & Dine Festival, Hong Kong WinterFest, and Hong Kong New Year Countdown Celebrations in the country. This should help further the resurgence of tourism.

Regional Performance Maintains Established Trends

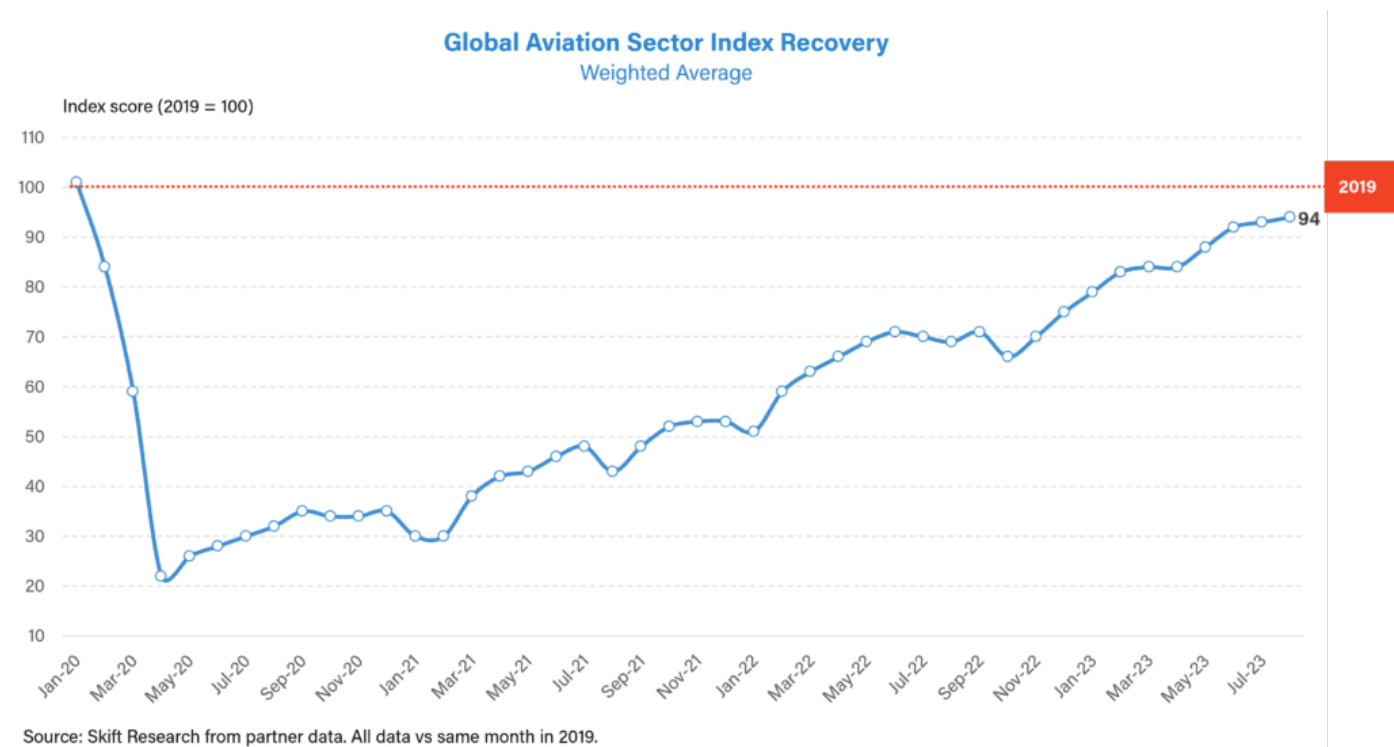
Similar to last year, all regions have either remained at the same level as July 2023 or witnessed slight performance gains. Except for Europe, which is just 1 pp short of 100, all regions show complete travel recovery. The global average growth is mainly driven by the 4 pp uptick in the Middle East and Africa.

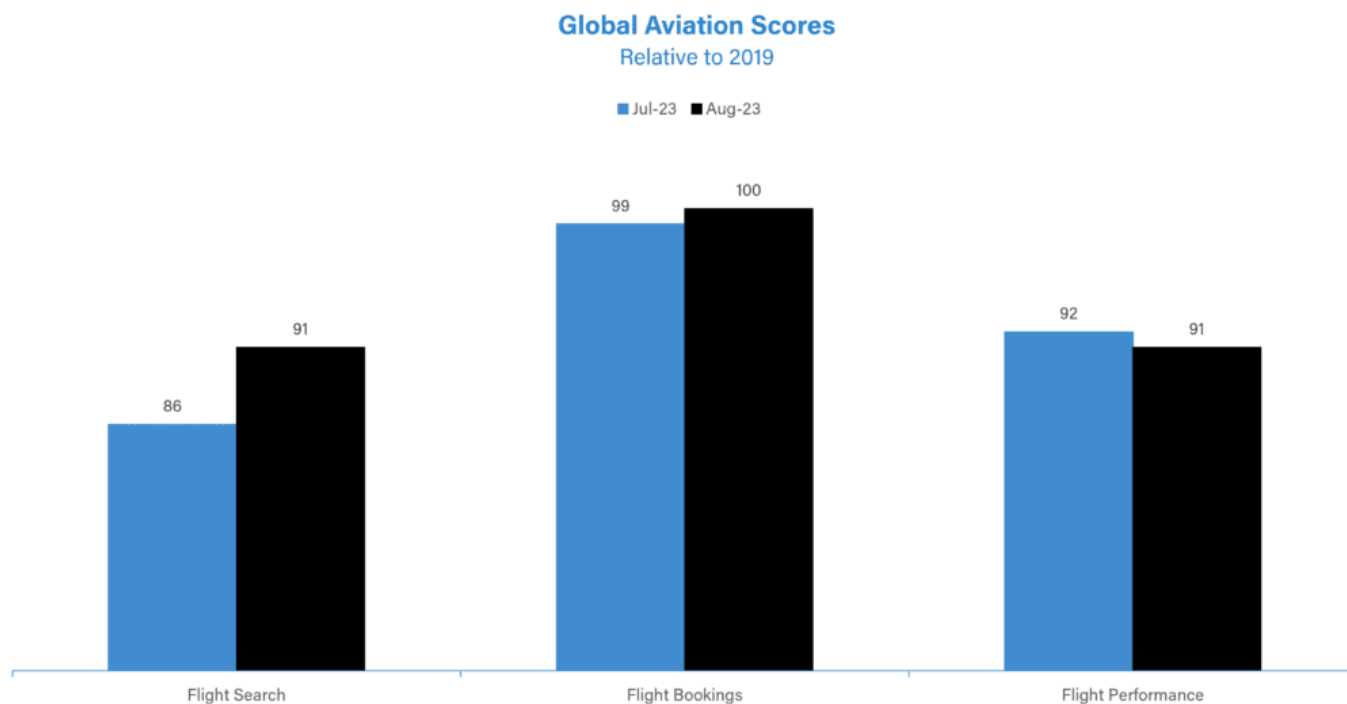

Global Aviation Recovery Appears to be on the Horizon

When looking at travel performance by sector, we note that although the aviation industry has had trouble fully recovering to levels seen in 2019, it has seen steady growth over the years. In August 2023, the sector index stands at 94 compared to a baseline of 100 in August 2019, bringing it closer to a complete recovery.



The improvement in the aviation index mainly comes from the uptick in global flight searches and the global average of flight bookings, indicating a full recovery in August 2023.

Looking at performance by region, we see that aviation performance in the Americas has surpassed pre-pandemic levels, boosting the global average. Asia Pacific, however, still remains the weakest region, with an 81% recovery.

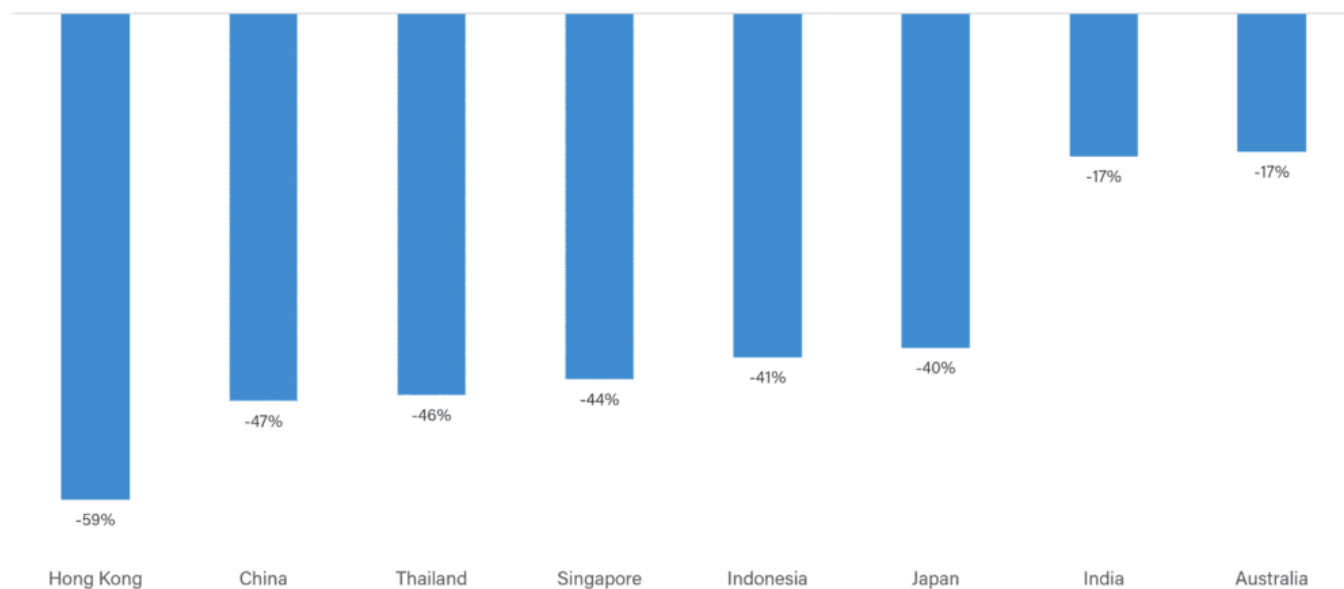

It is not just China that is holding the region back; travel arrivals to all countries in the Asia Pacific are on average 39% below 2019 levels this year. Thailand is taking steps such as granting temporary visa exemptions to tourists from China and Kazakhstan from September 25, 2023, to February 29, 2024. This should help boost tourist arrivals in the country.

Conclusion

The strugglers on our index, namely, aviation among the industries tracked and Hong Kong among the countries covered, both showed improving travel performance this month.

Hong Kong's dramatic rise is a result of the indexing of performance this month to that in August 2019, a period of unrest and low demand in the country. Although the travel industry has performed much better than that in the last few years, it will still be

a while before it recovers to its pre-pandemic average.

The aviation sector is only 6 pp short of making a complete recovery and is making slow progress towards the same. The Americas are providing the required boost to the sector, but Asia Pacific remains the black sheep holding back the sector's performance.

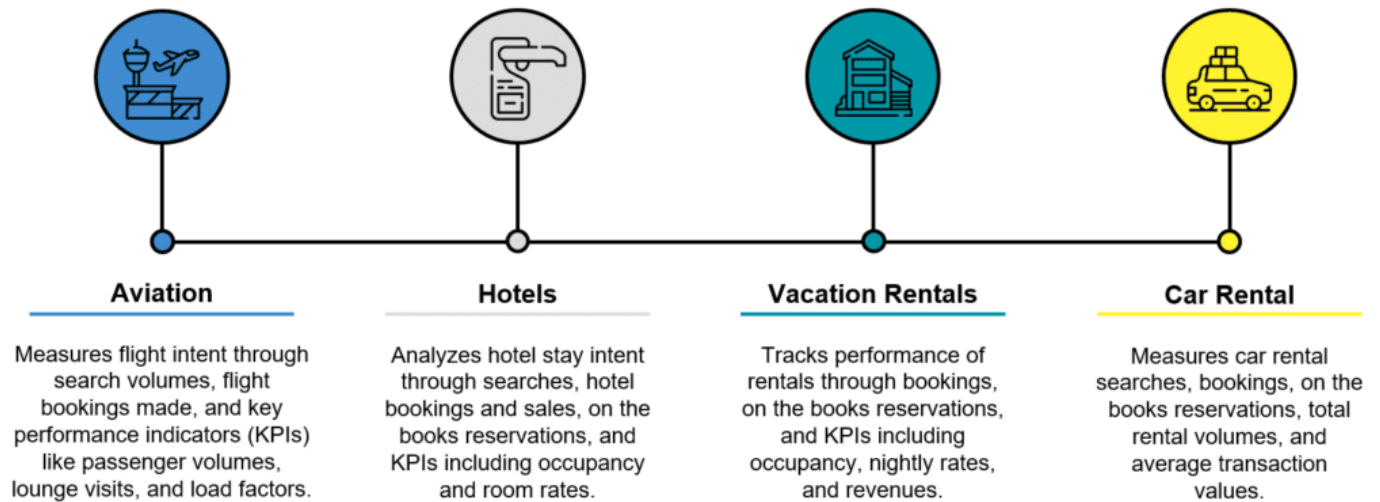
Skift Research collects and analyzes data from 22 different data partners, to provide the most comprehensive view of the travel industry's performance.

Index Design

The Index tracks 84 indicators per country to assess the health of the travel industry in each country. These indicators are aggregated into performance categories and sub-categories. The top level of division is by travel vertical, and each vertical is further divided by intent indicators, booking indicators, and key performance indicators.

The Index covers the following travel sectors:



Country Coverage

The Index focuses on the travel performance in 22 of the largest tourism economies, combined accounting for 62% of inbound tourism receipts, 67% of outbound tourism expenditure, and 78% of global 2019 GDP.

Index Score Calculation

The Index is designed to provide an easy overview of the health of the travel industry. We have tracked the industry since the beginning of 2020. For 2020, 2021, 2022, and 2023 data, the performance of each indicator is compared to the same time in 2019. The Index provides a score relative to a baseline reading of 100 for the same month in 2019.
