

Skift Travel Health Index June 2023 Highlights

The Skift Travel Health Index shows that all regions have recovered, but Europe's travel revival appears to be rather slow. With 17 out of 22 countries having fully recovered and Europe being a popular summer hotspot, the global travel industry has geared up for a bright summer season.

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
Executive Summary

The June 2023 Travel Health Index surpassed pre-pandemic performance again, this time with a 4 percentage point (pp) lead. With 17 out of 22 countries recovering fully, the global travel industry has geared up for a bright summer season.

All regions in the index have recovered, but Europe's travel revival seems to be rather slow. This report focuses on Europe's booming lodging sector compared to a slower transportation recovery. With Europe being a summer hotspot, the coming months could propel the region's Health Index forward.

Summer Travel Shines

The Travel Health Index indicates a bright tourism outlook this summer. As of June 2023, global travel performance soared 4 percentage points (pp) above 2019 levels. It stands at 104, gaining 1 pp over the previous month.





All Regions Have Recovered

Although some regions appear to have slowed down over the last month, all regions covered have achieved full recovery to pre-pandemic levels.



Russia and Germany have Held Europe Back

Most European countries covered by the Travel Health Index have recovered beyond pre-pandemic performance levels. Russia, however, continues to be the black sheep. Germany is taking small steps towards recovery and stands at 95% of 2019 levels as of June 2023.






European Destinations Most Popular for Summer Travel in 2023

A <u>recent study</u> by the European Travel Commission revealed that travel intent in Europe remains high despite a 4% decrease in the number of Europeans traveling. According to a recent report by <u>ForwardKeys</u>, globally, summer travelers flocked to destinations in Central America, Mexico, the Caribbean islands, and Southern Europe last summer because of restored connectivity and convenient travel requirements. This year has seen a significant shift towards Europe, according to search data from ForwardKeys, with Paris, London, and Barcelona all ranking highly. With Asia Pacific having finally lifted travel restrictions, Bangkok tops the list, and Bali looms large as well. However, when taken on the whole, European destinations dominate summer travel intent.



Most Searched Destinations for Travel in Summer 2023


Flight Search Volumes Indexed to 2022




The European Accommodation Sector Has Thrived

Hotels and vacation rentals have spearheaded Europe's travel recovery and are at 7% and 22% above 2019 levels, respectively. <u>Air traffic control issues</u> as well as <u>insufficient seat capacity</u> in Europe have led to a lot of delays and flight cancellations. The aviation sector, however, is only 3% short of achieving a complete recovery. Declining car rental bookings have led to a slump in the sector's performance.






Although the vacation rental sector's overall performance has recovered, occupancy levels appear to be slowing down in June 2023.



Hotel room nights growth in Europe is a mixed bag. The only countries where hotel room nights exceeded both 2019 and 2022 were the UK and France. Italy witnessed




an overall decline. Spain and Germany grew beyond 2022 but are yet to catch up to 2019 levels. Turkey's hotel demand was higher than in 2019 but lower than the previous year.



Strong Pricing has Driven European Recovery

Hotel published rates across all countries covered are much higher than 2019 levels and even higher than last year. Inflation in Europe has played a significant role in the rising hotel prices. For instance, with rising inflation, hotel costs in Turkey have increased significantly. This has impacted accommodation prices too. Higher pricing has helped hotels keep pace with spiking costs, but this does not entirely indicate driving recovery in an inflationary environment.





However, <u>24%</u> of European travelers worry about the overall rise in trip costs, while 17% are concerned with the economic situation and personal finances. It remains to be seen whether these concerns will impact Europe's travel performance in the coming months.

The Car Rental Sector Seems to be Cooling Off

Despite a month-over-month dip, global car rental performance is still 8 pp above pre-pandemic levels. All regions saw a decline in performance, except for North America, where it increased by 3 pp from May 2023.



Segmenting the sector's performance into searches and bookings, we see that while searches have been high this year, actualized car rental bookings are much lower.




Both domestic and inbound bookings have significantly declined across all countries covered.

Relative to 2019


■ Domestic ■ Inbound



With the exception of the U.S., where domestic car rental transaction values per day are lower than in 2019, all other countries have seen an increase in both inbound and domestic car rental transaction values.

Conclusion

The Travel Health Index surpassed its 2019 performance by 4 pp in June 2023, continuing to indicate that global travel is booming. 17 out of 22 countries are fully recovered in June 2023.

All regions in our index have now recovered. Although Europe has rebounded, the region's travel revival remains sluggish, largely because of Russia. Although travel performance in the region declined slightly over the previous month, it is a popular summer hotspot. The travel recovery has been fueled by high prices across the European lodging industry. There seems to be some price-related anxiety among European travelers, but how this would impact travel in Europe remains to be seen.



Methodology

Data Partners

Skift Research collects and analyzes data from 22 different data partners, to provide the most comprehensive view of the travel industry's performance.










Index Design

The Index tracks 84 indicators per country to assess the health of the travel industry



in each country. These indicators are aggregated into performance categories and sub-categories. The top level of division is by travel vertical, and each vertical is further divided by intent indicators, booking indicators, and key performance indicators.

The Index covers the following travel sectors:



Country Coverage

The Index focuses on the travel performance in 22 of the largest tourism economies, combined accounting for 62% of inbound tourism receipts, 67% of outbound tourism expenditure, and 78% of global 2019 GDP.

Index Score Calculation

The Index is designed to provide an easy overview of the health of the travel industry. We have tracked the industry since the beginning of 2020. For 2020, 2021, 2022, and 2023 data, the performance of each indicator is compared to the same time in 2019. The Index provides a score relative to a baseline reading of 100 for the same month in 2019.
